

Whanau will be receiving a letter shortly for those students below 70% attendance rate for Term 3. This is only for those with unexplained or unjustified reasons.


Please ensure when you contact the school promptly if your child is away with a reason for the absence. The teacher or office will then record this in their notes and assign the correct code.

Red brain and green brain are terms used to describe the different modes of mental response to a threat or a challenge. Red brain is the survival instinct that triggers anxiety, fear, anger or panic. Green brain is the executive and reasoned function that allows calm, rational, and positive thinking.

When a persona is anxious, their red brain takes over and they see everything as grim, sad or bad. Our Tamariki need time to transition from red brain to green before they can have a discussion or move on.

Our girls also had an exciting opportunity with a visit from the NZ Whai Women's Basketball Team, who ran an engaging skills and drills session for our basketball players.


Next week it is all about getting ready for School Athletic sports on Monday 4th November.
